*Your* MOSHE chapter continues to explore opportunities to expand our Chapter's membership in conjunction with expanding the value of MOSHE membership.

As the 2013 President of MOSHE, I will seek to increase the diversity of membership within our current hospitals; i.e., Environmental Safety & Health, Patient Safety, etc., as well as reaching out to those hospital in the rural areas. Coordinating with Peg Johnston, Membership Chairwoman, and Martin Grabanski, Communication/Marketing Chairman, we will broadcast the increased value of membership by initiating two new programs. MOSHE is applying for an MHA grant funding in relationship to a "Grow Your Own" education program. Grant funding will support a state wide series of workshop to increase our member's Certified Healthcare Facilities Manager, CHFM. Beginning next

month, via the MOSHE website, you will be able to review current reports from chapter hospitals that have recently been surveyed by Joint Commission.

Brad Taylor's Education Committee continue to produce outstanding programs. The March program is representative of high level speakers schedule throughout this year. The program presented by Susan B. McLaughlin, sharing the latest information pertaining to the Joint Commission standards and expectation drew a record breaking audience. April's education program directed towards Infection Control application in Design, Construction, Renovation and Maintenance, held in Columbia, should be a "must, not to be missed" session, in light of pending Federal infection control discussions. Future programs promise to continue the excitement. The October seminar to be held at the Forest Hill Country Club is a "first" for our chapter. Mike Bock, Scholarship Chairman, has recommended meaningful recommendations to the distribution of scholarships (see related article on page 3).

Fred Waldrop and his committee has continued to "pull out the stops" with this year's golf tournament. This year's event will be held at the Innsbrook Resort and Conference Center in Innsbrook, Missouri. This site has been consistently voted as one of the premier public courses in the state of Missouri. Early reservations are highly recommended.

Effective January, 2013, MOSHE initiated charging no-show fees at the education program. The purpose in charging a fee for no-shows is to help cover the cost of the education programs for the meals and other program related expenses based on the number of registered attendees. At the last Board meeting, the Board approved charging the no-show facility members cost to \$15.00 instead of the \$50.00. However, the no show cost for everyone else will remain at \$50.00.

As initially mentioned, I plan to tour throughout the state of Missouri this summer; to share MOSHE's mission of providing meaningful and pertinent healthcare related education via membership with MOSHE as well as ASHE.

## Revised Scholarship Program
