How fortunate it was for me that the week before my survey, MOSHE had hosted Susan McLaughlin with an educational program giving all of us a Joint Commission update. The timing, as well as the content, was priceless for me personally. MOSHE is always striving to make a difference in your job as well with our education programs.

I have selected two initiatives that I would like to accomplish this year as your MOSHE President. First of all we are going to be refreshing the MOSHE Bylaws to provide a greater level of detail and to include the best practices used by other ASHE professional member groups. Second, I will be chartering a new standing committee for MOSHE that will address recommended codes for the State of Missouri. The current healthcare regulations in Missouri are a mix of state regulations and obsolete versions of the *Life Safety Code* and other NFPA codes. While all of us can agree that the state regulations need to be updated, we don't have a dedicated advocacy group with the time and energy to push this change through the legislative process. I also feel that the best and most appropriate organizations to recommend and advocate for this change are MOSHE and MHA. I think all of us can agree that facility engineering professionals like us are the best and most appropriate decision makers regarding codes and standards for our hospitals in the State of Missouri.
