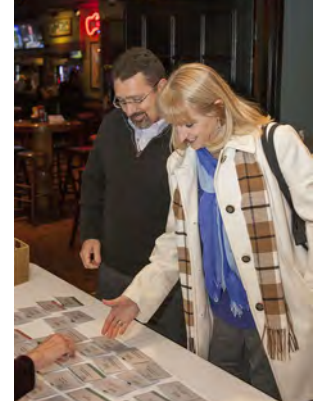
Sponsorship Committee
